
The Resources are divided into Subject Categories. Click the subject you want.

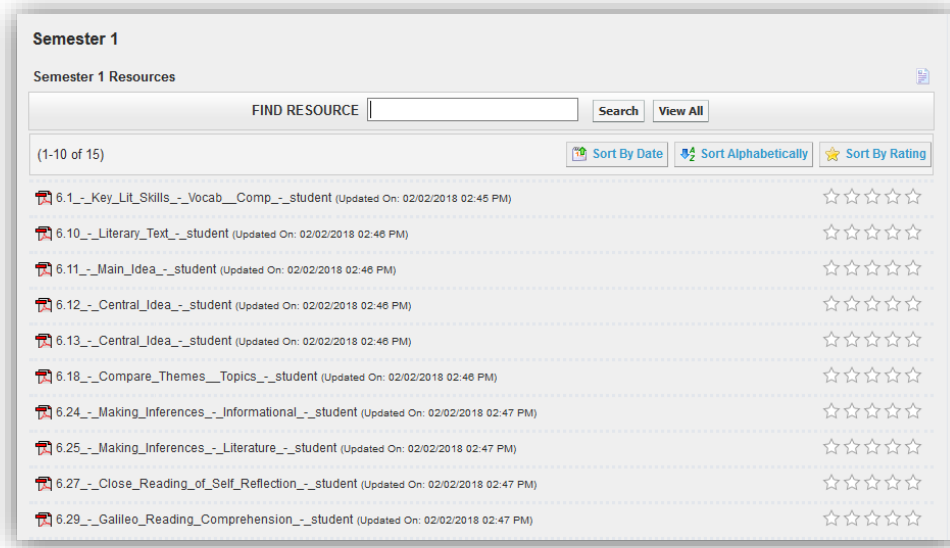
In the grade level, you might find the resources divided into more specific categories.

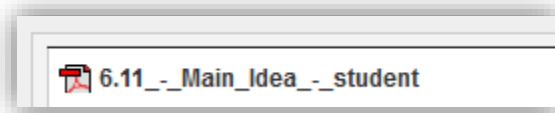
